

## **Keyboard Buying Guide**

There are many keyboards on the market. Look for models that are sturdy and well-made rather than 'toy' versions. A useful feature is a screen which indicates chosen functions and often has a stave with note representation.

Prices start at around £100-£150

A basic model should have:

- **Full size keys**
- **Preferably 61 keys**
- **An *Accompaniment/Fingered* function for using chords**
- **Touch sensitive (Not essential for beginners but required for exams)**
- **Power adapter**

Plenty of specialist music shops and websites offer good deals including stands and cases.
